UG/PB:

- EDUC 301/302 must be taken quarters one and two or two and three.
- IT 444 must be taken prior to or concurrent with Sec 431. Exceptions must be approved by the department chair or program manager.
- SpEd 363 should be taken concurrent or after Sec 431; however we can be flexible to accommodate student schedules.
- Sec 432/433/436 should be taken as close to student teaching as possible. If you have extensive major endorsement coursework to take, spread out your education coursework in a way that accomplishes this.

UG only If your major department does not offer a writing intensive course, you need register for a WI section of Sec 411 to meet university requirements.

MIT only IT 544 is offered 3 times a year – winter, spring, summer
 SpEd 510 (old 562b) is offered 3 times a year – winter, spring, summer

All Students:

- Include first quarter courses
- Include ALL course – education, major, remaining GURs, etc.
- Include credits for all courses
- Indicate whether on financial aid, and schedule student teaching accordingly
 - On financial aid: Register for 12 credits each quarter
 - Not on financial aid: Fall/winter – 18 cr/6 cr.
 - Winter/spring – 6 cr/18 cr.
- Sec 495/595 (student teaching) options:
 - Semester** – fall/winter or winter/spring
 - Quarter (Global Internships only)** any quarter (fall, winter, spring, summer)
